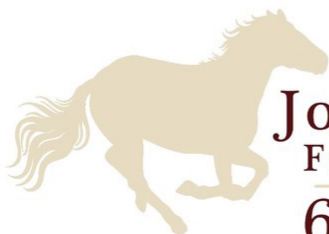

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Pre-entries CLOSE FRIDAY JUNE 7th at noon. Pre-entries will be accepted online at www.horseshowing.com, or with the enclosed information from the entry form by e-mail to hmthompson52@msn.com.
2. Entry fee is \$20.00 per class. Derby class is \$40. Must have eight entries to hold the class and pay prize money. You must compete in one full division to be eligible to compete in the Derby.
3. A \$20 fee will be charged to all entries to cover EMT/grounds/admin fees.
4. Post entries will be accepted at \$25 per class.
5. A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for each junior rider who wishes to be eligible for the Best Child Rider Award.
6. Entries and counts will be posted on Horseshowing.com.
7. Junior riders shall not have reached their 18th birthday prior to December first of the previous year.
8. ASTM/SEI helmets are required for all competitors at all times while mounted.
9. The Show Committee reserves the right to change the order of classes and make cancellations if so warranted.
10. Dogs will not be permitted on the show grounds unless restrained on a lead.
11. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class.
12. A negative coggins test taken within the 12 month period prior to the show date must be available upon request.
13. Martingales prohibited in under saddle classes.
14. Show management has the right to dismiss any horse or rider deemed unsafe.
15. The decision of the judges and/or show managers shall be final.
16. Exhibitors must scratch at the secretary's stand.
17. Attire: Neat, clean & workmanlike. Tack & equipment as for recognized competition. Boots on your horse are OK for warm-up area but they must be removed prior to entering the show ring.

18. Food and drink will be available for purchase.
19. The horse show committee, show managers, show organizers, show staff, Pickering Hunt Pony Club, US Pony Club, Show Grounds or property owners or any of its employees or affiliates will NOT be responsible for any damage, loss, theft, injury or death to persons, horse/pony, or property of any exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the show grounds.
20. All other USEF rules apply.
21. All CDC guidelines and state/local laws will be followed.
22. Please be courteous to all volunteers, officials and fellow competitors. Please follow safe practices while in the warm-up ring.
23. Parking will be on grass. Please bring a mucktub for cleanup around your trailer and take manure home. Port-a-pot will be available on the show grounds.

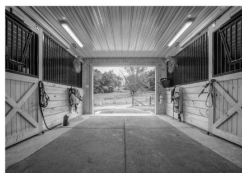
